The WAMC Department of Pharmacy is among the busiest of all the Armed Forces pharmacies. We constantly strive to make improvements in our level of patient care through the implementation of innovative processes and programs.

In addition to fulfilling the prescription needs of the Fort Bragg active duty, dependent, and retiree population, we also provide training for patients in the use of glucometers, see patients in the WAMC Coumadin Clinic, provide training for hospital staff, and see patients who remain with WAMC in an inpatient status. Our award-winning military and civilian staff, represents some of the best pharmacy personnel in the Army.

We utilize innovations in pharmacy technology such as robotics, Web services

and various counting technologies to fulfill patient needs quickly and safely. We provide this web resource for you, our patients, in an effort to keep you informed, and to enhance our service to you.

The Department of Pharmacy conducts one-hour glucometer conversion classes from 10 to 11 a.m. on the first Friday (with the exception of holidays and training holidays) of each month. The location is the WAMC Nutrition Clinic classroom — Rm. CG 1007-1. This is in the basement next to the Dining Facility. Classes are open to active duty, military retirees and dependents. You can now request refills online at www.express-scripts.com/TRICARE. Our new online service enables you to order up to 22 prescriptions per patient. Since the prescription numbers are typed in,

many patients say that the service eliminates the confusion they experienced with the automated call-in system. The automated call-in system is still available for those who wish to use it or are not comfortable with web-based technology.

You may mail your prescriptions in to the Department of Pharmacy. Please ensure that all contact information is included on the front of the prescription to include name, address, telephone number, and sponsor social security number. Prescriptions will need to be picked up at the WAMC pharmacy. We do not mail out medications. Please allow adequate time for your mailed in prescription(s) to reach us. The mail in address is:
