Several of the thefts have taken place at service members' homes on post.

The thefts occurred between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. and the 82nd Airborne Division area continues to be the most affected area on Fort Bragg.

The Criminal Investigation Division is asking the Fort Bragg community to take extra precautions when securing private motorcycles. They suggest securing motorcycles to a stabilized item in a well-illuminated area.

It is further recommended that any suspicious person(s) towing trailers through housing areas, during late hours, should be reported to Military Police.
