A new session of the American Red Cross Dental Assistant Course will begin at the Pope Dental Clinic on Jan. 4, 2007. The comprehensive program requires a commitment of eight hours a day, five days a week for a six month period. The course will begin with two weeks of classroom instruction, followed by 23 weeks of on-the-job training in general dentistry techniques and procedures. 
