

# Fort Bragg shuttle helps Soldiers, environment

Many Soldiers and reservists who live and work on Fort Bragg don't always have the luxury of a vehicle to travel on post.

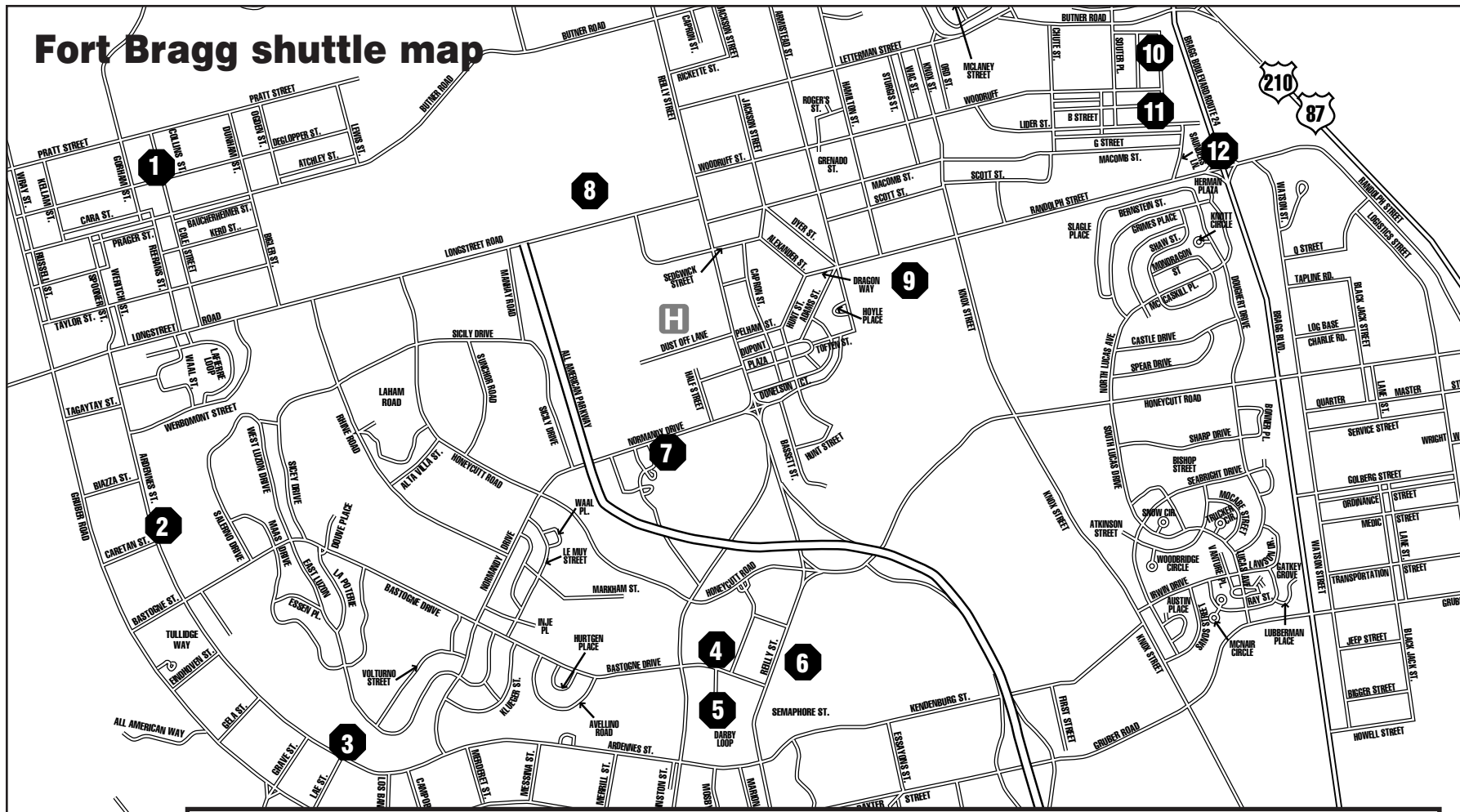
Fort Bragg's shuttle service can help the transportation blues by taking a rider around post from the Non-commissioned officer Club to a connection to downtown Fayetteville via the Fayetteville Area System Transit.

An advantage of having the shuttle is in line with Fort Bragg's commitment to clean air. Fort Bragg and the surrounding community have agreed to an Environmental Protection Agency Early Action Compact, according to Charles Young, a sustainable transportation planner for the Fort Bragg Directorate of Public Works Environment Section.

"The EAC is an agreement between our community, North Carolina Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources, and the Environmental Protection Agency for reducing ground level ozone emissions. Fort Bragg's local action plan includes the installation shuttle and the resulting clean air benefits of public transportation." Young said. "Use of the intra-post shuttle reduces traffic, paving land for additional parking spaces, and works to clean the air," he added.

The shuttle bus service, provided by the 2125th Garrison Support Unit, is free to Soldiers. There is no service Mondays and federal holidays. A one-way trip on the FAST city bus costs 75 cents. Riders must carry exact change with them as FAST drivers do not carry change.

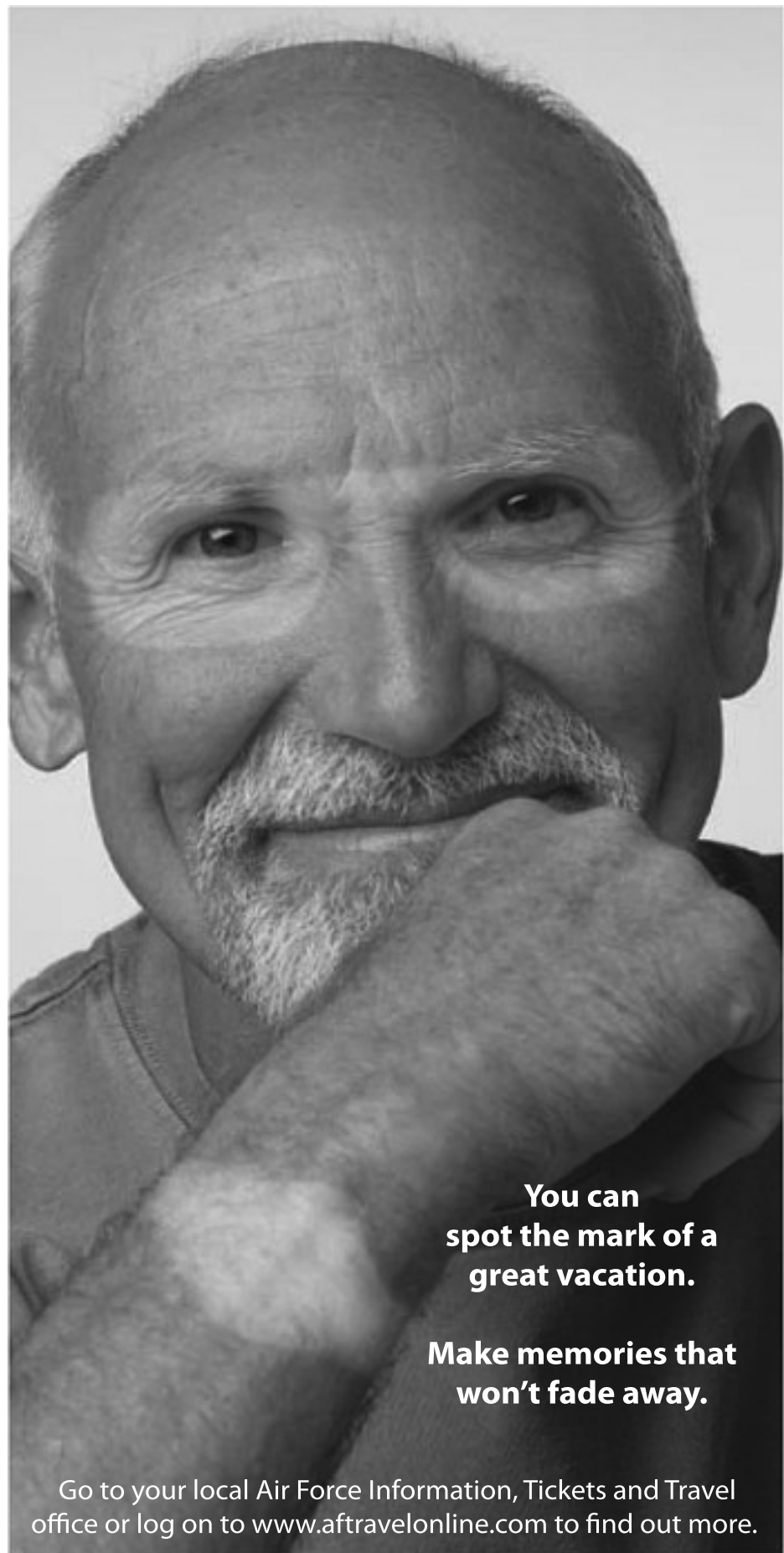
